


# Secured and controlled slopes

All official and secured pistes are marked with a pole on each side. Ski routes are only marked with one pole — stay ten meters left or right of the poles. When you leave a marked piste or ski route, you are in the open ski area. This area is neither marked or groomed, not controlled and not secured. As only the open and marked pistes are controlled\* by the piste patrol and the piste rescue service, skiers and snowboarders who leave the marked pistes must be aware that they do so at their own risk. Be warned that you are entering a dangerous area where there may be rocks, treacherous slopes, etc.
